## **November revenue receipts meet monthly target**

Nov. 27, 2013

TOPEKA – The Kansas economy continued to show signs of steady growth Wednesday with November sales tax receipts beating projections.

“It is encouraging to see sales tax receipts topping expectations because that means people and businesses are confident enough in the economy to spend their money,” said Revenue Secretary Nick Jordan. “Lowering the individual income tax rates has let people hold on to more of the money they earned. They are now able to spend it as they see fit.”

Sales tax receipts were \$1.1 million more than anticipated or about 1 percent.

Overall, fiscal year to date revenue receipts remain on target with budget estimates
