

ORDINANCE NO. 1414

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE CITY OF HOISINGTON, KANSAS

WHEREAS, the following described land adjoins the City of Hoisington, Kansas, and is generally located on the Northwestern boundary of the City; and

WHEREAS, a written consent to annexation of the following described land, signed by the owner thereof, has been filed with the City of Hoisington, Kansas pursuant to K.S.A. 12-520, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Hoisington, Kansas finds it advisable to annex such land;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HOISINGTON, KANSAS:

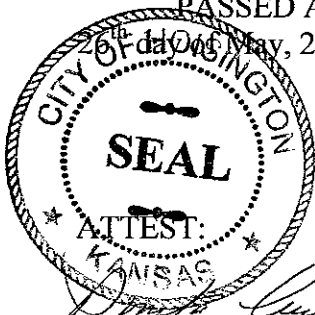
SECTION 1. That the following described land is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of Hoisington, Kansas:

That part of the Southwest Quarter of Section 32, Township 17 South, Range 13 West of the 6th Principal Meridian, Barton County, Kansas, described as follows:

Commencing at the southeast corner of the Southwest Quarter of said Section 32; thence on an assumed bearing of North 00 degrees 06 minutes 18 seconds West, along the east line of the Southwest Quarter of said section, a distance of 80.40 feet to the north right-of-way line of Highway 4; thence on a bearing of South 89 degrees 59 minutes 29 seconds West, along the north right-of-way line of said Highway, a distance of 450.00 feet to the point of beginning of the land to be described; thence continuing on a bearing of South 89 degrees 59 minutes 29 seconds West, along the north right-of-way line of said Highway, a distance of 197.50 feet; thence on a bearing of North 00 degrees 06 minutes 18 seconds West a distance of 173.00 feet; thence on a bearing of North 89 degrees 59 minutes 29 seconds East a distance of 197.50 feet; thence on a bearing of South 00 degrees 06 minutes 18 seconds East a distance of 173.00 feet to the point of beginning.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
