**ORDINANCE NO. 1750**

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO THE  
CITY OF MARYSVILLE, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the following described land is located in Marshall County, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Marysville, Kansas, finds it advisable to annex such land which is owned by the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF MARYSVILLE, KANSAS;

SECTION 1. That the following described land is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of Marysville, Kansas:

A tract in the West Half of the Northeast Quarter of Section 27, Township 2 South, Range 7 East, Marshall County, Kansas, described as follows: Starting at the Southwest corner of the Northeast Quarter of said Section 27; thence Easterly (Az. 90° 28' 14") along the South line of said Northeast Quarter for 420.40 feet to the point of beginning; thence Northerly (Az. 359° 44' 01") for 519.50 feet; thence Easterly (Az. 90° 28' 14") for 250.00 feet; thence Southerly (Az. 179° 44' 01") for 519.55 feet to the South line of said Northeast Quarter; thence Westerly (Az. 270° 28' 14") along said South line for 250.00 feet to the point of beginning, containing 2.98 acres, more or less, of which 0.28 acres is reserved for public road right-of-way and subject to easements, restrictions and rights-of-way both visible and of record (Old Treasure Hut Property);

SECTION 2. That the property described in Section 1 above be and the same is hereby attached to the First Ward of the City of Marysville, Kansas.

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.

PASSED BY THE COUNCIL AND APPROVED BY THE MAYOR of the City of Marysville, Kansas, this 24th day of August, 2009.

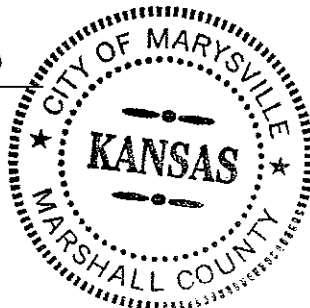

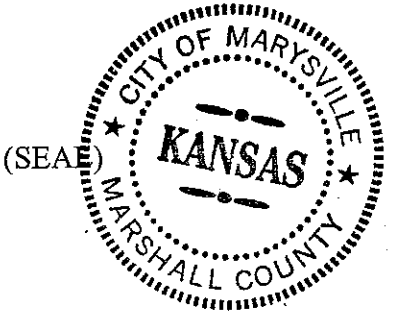
