

ORDINANCE NO. G-1074

**AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING LAND TO
THE CITY OF EL DORADO, KANSAS.**

WHEREAS, the following described land is in Butler County, Kansas;

WHEREAS, the following described land, meets one or more of the conditions prescribed by K.S.A. 12-520(c) and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of El Dorado, Kansas, finds it advisable to annex such land.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE
CITY OF EL DORADO, KANSAS:**

Section 1. That the following described land, meeting the conditions for annexation prescribed in K.S.A. 12-520, is hereby annexed and made a part of the City of El Dorado, Kansas:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of the West-half of the Southeast Quarter (SE4) of Section 1, Township 26 South, Range 5 East of the Sixth Principal Meridian in Butler County, Kansas; thence West along the South line of said West-half a distance of 1315.09 feet to the Southwest corner of said Southeast Quarter (SE4); thence West along the South line of the East-half of the Southwest Quarter (SW4), a distance of 649.08 feet on an assumed bearing of S89°59'30"W; thence N49°23'E, a distance of 1620.88 feet to a 5/8" bar; thence N65°09'46"E, a distance of 796.86 feet to a point on the East line of said West-half Southeast Quarter (SE4); thence South along the East line of said West-half, a distance of 1390.03 feet to the Point of Beginning. Said tract contains 35.37 Acres including the road Right-of-way.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
