Vineyard Permit Application and Agreement Instructions

Who can apply for this permit?

Any vineyard located in Kansas with a minimum of 100 grape vines may apply.

What can I do with this permit?

A permitted vineyard may purchase wine from the Kansas farm winery that purchased their grapes. The wine purchased must contain all or part of the permitted vineyards grapes. The vineyard may give samples or sell wine by the bottle for off-premise consumption. If located in a county that has approved liquor by the drink, the vineyard may sell wine by the glass.

Requirements to Obtain a Kansas Vineyard Permit:

- A. Vineyard Permit Application and Agreement (ABC-1018).
- B. \$100.00 Vineyard Permit Fee.
- C. Copy of your Alcohol Dealer Registration form (TTB F 5630.5d). You must make a copy of this form prior to submitting it to the TTB.
- D. Business Tax Application Booklet (KS-1216) or apply for taxes online. Liquor Drink and Liquor Enforcement taxes apply for this permit.

Instructions to Complete the ABC-1018 Vineyard Permit Application and Agreement:

1. Permit Type.
 - a. New Permit. Check the "New Permit" box if you do not have a Kansas Vineyard Permit or if your Kansas Vineyard Permit has been expired for more than 30 days.
 - b. Renew Permit. Check the "Renew Permit" box to renew your current Kansas Vineyard Permit.
2. Check the appropriate "Application Entity Type", complete, sign and date the Vineyard Permit Application and Agreement form, print your name and title.
3. Complete the attached Vineyard Permit Voucher.
 - a. New Permit. Check the "New Permit" box, enter the name as it appears on the Vineyard Permit Application and Agreement and check the box to indicate your \$100 Permit Fee is attached. Answer the questions in the "New Permits Only" section.
 - b. To Renew Permit. Check the "Renew Permit" box, enter your Vineyard Name, Vineyard Permit Number and check the box to indicate your \$100 Permit Fee is attached.
4. Make your check payable to the "Kansas Department of Revenue" and attach it to the completed Vineyard Permit Voucher below.
5. Return the original completed Vineyard Permit Agreement, a copy of your Basic Permit or Brewer's Notice and \$100 Vineyard Permit fee to the ABC Marketing Unit.

- f. It will abide by all the provisions of the Kansas Liquor Control Act and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.
